

RESIDENT/FELLOW STATISTICAL ANALYSIS POLICY

Bridgeport Hospital encourages scholarly activity by residents and fellows during their training.

Scholarly activity is supported in a number of ways including:

- Reimbursement for conference/travel to present scholarly activity;
- Science and Education Day, our annual recognition program; and
- Access to statistical analysis for resident/fellow scholarly projects.

Residents/fellows requiring statistical analysis must complete the Statistical Analysis GME Approval Form, obtain Program Director approval and return to the Department of Academic Affairs for approval by the DIO. If approved, the GME office will forward an email with a copy of the signed approval form to both the contact at Yale Center for Analytic Sciences, as well as the resident/fellow to initiate the request for services. It is the responsibility of the resident/fellow to follow-up directly with the Yale contact concerning their scholarly project and the statistical analysis services requested.

Residents/fellows will initially be granted up to five (5) hours of approved statistical services provided by faculty at the Yale Center for Analytical Sciences at Yale University School of Public Health. Additional services (time over 5 hours) must be pre-approved by GME.

If a resident/fellow is provided with funding for statistical analysis, the resulting scholarly work must be presented at Science and Education Day.

The Department of Academic Affairs will be billed directly for these services.
