

# WHAT HAPPENS IF MY LOVED ONE IS BROUGHT TO THE EMERGENCY ROOM AND PASSES AWAY UNEXPECTEDLY?

#### **FAMILY INFORMATION SHEET**

The death of a family member can feel bewildering and emotionally overwhelming. Greenwich Hospital has spiritual care and other support services available to provide support around the death of a loved one. Should you feel a need to discuss your feelings and reactions with a professional at the hospital, we will provide the emotional and spiritual support you request. In addition to this support, we have compiled the following information to help you to know what to expect at this difficult time.

- 1. If the police have been notified, it is because we were not able to reach you immediately.
- 2. After you have said your farewells and left the hospital, your loved one will be prepared for transfer to the morgue.
- No detailed administrative or legal forms need be filled out before leaving the hospital. The nurse will only ask you to sign a list detailing personal belongings of your loved one that you wish to take home.
- 4. Arrangements with a funeral home can be made from home. A list of funeral homes and cremation services in the immediate area is attached.
- 5. Our concern for your well being through the grieving process continues after you leave the hospital. Greenwich Hospital Hospice provides a bereavement support group for family members. This group is free and open to anyone in the community. A contact for this group and information about other such groups is attached.
